Bioethics Teaching Demonstrations and Participatory Moral Games

The morning will introduce the latest ideas, theory and debates in environmental and medical ethics, as a theoretical introduction to the subject. The afternoon will introduce the rationale for bioethics education through hands-on methods for educators to use in teaching ethics, with participatory examples in ethics of science and technology, and environmental ethics. Feedback from participants is also encouraged, and some pilot projects in partner institutions will be initiated as follow-up.

Registration is free. The language of the course will be English, and it is designed for teachers at international schools, and university. Others may also attend.

The intensive course will be given by Professor Darryl Macer, Ph.D., Regional Adviser in Social and Human Sciences for Asia and the Pacific, Regional Unit for Social and Human Sciences in Asia and the Pacific (RUSHSAP), UNESCO Bangkok.
